On July 8, 2017, we received word from Supreme Jurisprudence that the reformatting of the Oregon Manual of Rules and Regulations had been approved and could be published.

This is a major accomplishment for our jurisdiction and I am excited to let you know that the new version has been published to our website: [www.oriojd.org/](http://www.oriojd.org/) under the Information tab / Bylaws / Oregon Bylaws 2016-17 Reformat.

The Rules and Regulations of the Grand Bethel of Oregon and the Miss Oregon Job's Daughter Program have been separated out and are published separately because they have not yet been reformatted. These are located in the same area for easy use and reference. We anticipate these will be reformatted in the coming year when Supreme Jurisprudence reformats the Supreme Bethel and Miss International Job's Daughter Rules and Regulations.

We will NOT publish written copies of this document until we receive approval from Supreme Jurisprudence to incorporate the 2017 amendments recently adopted at Grand Session in Newport and a final document is prepared for our use. We anticipate this will be sometime in August.
