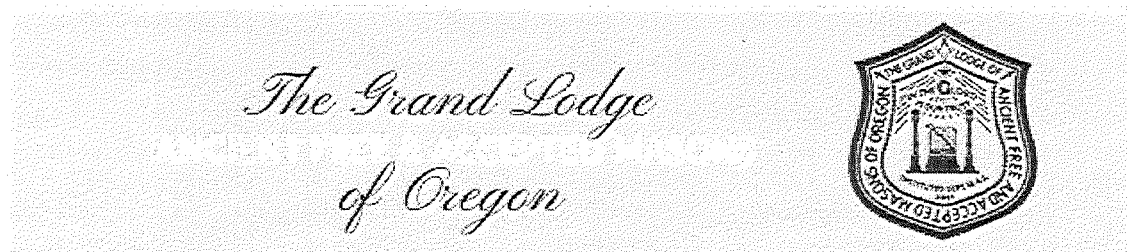

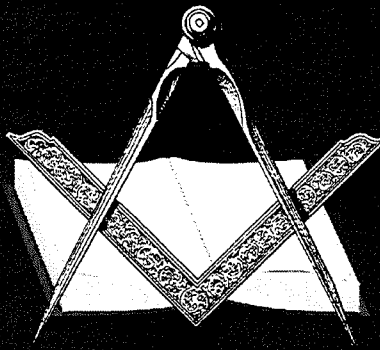

and debit cards for sales about two years ago. Many nonprofit, charitable organizations want to maximize donations in easy and convenient ways. We are often asked how a Job's Daughter member can use PayPal to track and receive donations given as a credit toward her own fundraising goals - to get into that excellent and brilliant group of young ladies in the \$1,000 Club! So, here are three simple steps.

Step 1 - Ask your donor to use our direct link to PayPal.

Step 2 - Have your donor enter the amount and select their method of donation - PayPal account, or with a debit or credit card. Perhaps they would consider making it a recurring monthly donation? (They can cancel or change the recurring donation and amount anytime via their PayPal account.)

Step 3 - This is the *Critical Step* - Provide the name of the Job's Daughter, the Bethel number, City and State to receive the donation credit in the space that says, "**Add Special**

Add special instructions to the seller:

Instructions to the Seller."

Don't forget this piece of information before filling out the payment confirmation details, and checking the box to share your mailing address with us so we can say "Thank you!"

As a follow-up, remind your donor to forward their confirmed payment email to you so you can add it to your tracking form.

Just wanted to take a minute and update you on how things are going here.

For those who may not know, Ken has been diagnosed with stage IV lung cancer that has moved to his bones, lymph nodes, and other lung. He then further complicated things by falling on the way out of the BR, fracturing his R tibia on Sept 6th. He has a brace on his leg which further complicates his ability to get around.

He is continuing to decline slowly, but still has his sense of humor and comes up with some funny comments. I have gotten him on Hospice and his pain is under control. He still enjoys short visits or calls from friends but sleeps a lot. Some confusion makes his safety a risk so I have someone staying with him whenever I am at work, thanks to the adult son of a friend of ours.

Son, Mike, and his family have been very supportive. Daughter, Kendra has applied for FMLA (Family Medical Leave) and her work has been great. She and Nathan have been back and forth a lot this past 3 months and will be up the first week of Nov to stay and help out. Thus far she has two months scheduled off, if needed.

We are hanging in there and do so appreciate all of your kind words and prayers of encouragement. I have touched base with almost all of his side of the family as well, and I talked to all but one of his Aunts on the phone this past week.

As we move into this holiday season, I pray for each of you to take time to tell your loved ones how much you appreciate them, have faith, and keep smiling.
