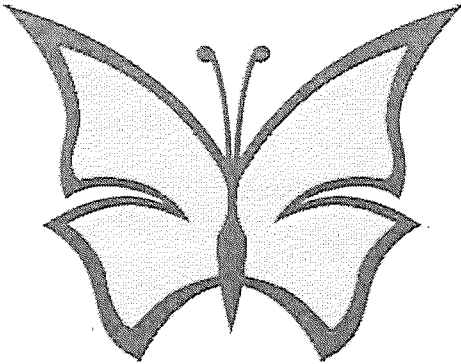
We will be changing the look of the Grand Mailing in the months to come. We are working towards changes that will make information more accessible and concise and easier for Bethels to work with in their meetings.

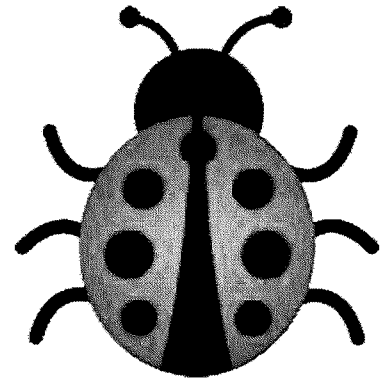

Dear Job's Daughters, Council Members & Supporters,

As you all know, a Bethel's paraphernalia wears out and needs to be replaced on occasion. The same is true about the paraphernalia that the Supreme Bethel owns. This letter specifically deals with the Supreme Bethel capes.

The Supreme Bethel Honored Queen and Princesses have two sets of capes. The Official Set is worn rarely as they are only used for the Supreme Bethel meeting, Supreme Bethel Installation and helping to institute a new Bethel. The second set are known as their travel capes. These travel capes, especially the Supreme Bethel Honored Queen's cape is worn weekly if not more often. The current set of travel capes are on their seventh year. The useful life of these travel capes is truly only 5 years, so we find ourselves overdue and with a Supreme Bethel Honored Queen cape that is in severe need of replacement.

We have been able to obtain a reasonable bid to produce three new capes, but as this was not budgeted we are asking for some help. All 3 capes need to be matched for replacement and our fundraising goal is \$1,500. Therefore, the Supreme Bethel and Finance committees are reaching out to you to start a cape replacement donation campaign. Keep in mind any donations received are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law. In addition, you will receive a lovely thank you note from our current Supreme Bethel Honored Queen, Aimee Bright.

## Insurance and Form 125

The Board of Trustees has been looking for ways to allow the Daughters to have fun and at the same time keep us safe from liability risks. Although this will not completely protect us, the use the Release, Waiver and Consent Form 125 (see attached) will give us some protection.

If your Bethel asks each Daughter to complete Form 125 **prior** to an athletic event, then you will not need to cancel planned activities. These forms should be collected by a member of the Executive Bethel Guardian Council and kept in the Bethel's files for a minimum of one year.

There are still some activities that are not allowed, even with the use of Form 125: Bethels may not participate in trampoline parks; zip lining; paint ball; and rock climbing. Swimming is allowed in pools when a certified life guard is present. Swimming in lakes, rivers, or the ocean is not permitted.

**Please don't forget** to email a list of your Bethel's activities so that we may acquire a liability policy that will protect the entire Order. Email your activities to [sgc@iojd.org](mailto:sgc@iojd.org). Tell us your Bethel number, state and the type of activity by November 1, 2017.

If the parent or legal guardian's written permission has not been obtained before hand, and if in the CAV's best judgment it is safer to share a room with the Daughter than to have separate rooms for the Daughter and the female CAV under the circumstances of the particular trip, the two may share the same room.
