2020 Oregon Rose Award

In an effort to find a way to honor those special adult workers who give extra effort and time to help their Bethel and Oregon Job's Daughters prosper, the Executive Grand Guardian Council has created the Oregon Rose Award. Current Executive Grand Guardian Council officers are not eligible for nomination for this award.

The Oregon Rose is unique to our jurisdiction. Anyone may submit a nomination for this award and the nominee can be a man or a woman. We will require at least one letter of recommendation along with the nomination form. This doesn't mean you have to stop at one letter or at one nominee.

The Executive Grand Guardian Council will meet in June and will make final selections. Recipients will be kept secret until the presentation at Grand Session.

There is no requirement for the recipients to have been a Bethel Guardian or Associate Guardian. In fact, they don't have to have been on a Bethel Council at all! Any adult who supported a Bethel with exceptional service and dedication (above and beyond what would be considered usual service) may be nominated. We know that there are a lot of terrific adults who would qualify.
