It is time for seniors in high school, college age daughters and majority members to request a scholarship packet and begin collecting the information needed to submit their application for an Oregon Job's Daughters Scholarship.

In order to reach as many daughters as possible, I hope that you will assist me by getting the word out to any and all daughters and majority members who are in good standing with your Bethel. Please think about girls that are just getting ready to graduate from high school as well as those who may already be in college and those who may have taken some time off and are now thinking about going back to school.

Be sure to share with them that the educational purpose for these scholarships shall include any formal post-high-school education, including community colleges, 4-year colleges and universities, and business or vocational training.

Additionally, part of the application requires Bethel Guardian Council recommendations. Please be prompt, thorough, and kind in your submissions.

Scholarships are awarded based on the following criteria:

- Financial Need
- Job's Daughters Activities
- Academic record
- Personal Statement from Daughter
- Recommendation of Executive members of the Bethel Guardian Council

To apply for a scholarship, a Daughter may request an application packet from the Educational Scholarship Committee Chairperson. Her request should include name, phone number, email address and Bethel number. All requests and received packets will be acknowledged. Applications must be received by midnight April 3, 2020. 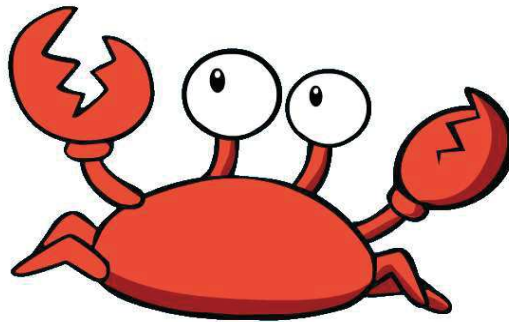
